Global Philanthropy Environment Index

- Formerly the Index of Philanthropic Freedom
- Explores how conducive countries' policies are to philanthropy, both domestically and internationally
- Identifies barriers and incentives for individuals and organizations to engage in social causes




The Global Philanthropy Environment Index

- What Does the 2018 Report Tell Us?
 - Restrictive overall philanthropic environment in 40% of 79 economies
 - Improved regulatory conditions for philanthropy in 6 of the 11 regions from 2015
 - Challenging political environment for philanthropy
 - More restricted cross-border flows vs.




2018 Global Philanthropy Environment Index Scores by Region




Overall Score by Region










Score on Ease of Operating by Region








Score on Tax Incentives by Region






Score on Cross-Border Flows by Region








Score on Political Environment by Region










Percentage of Change in the Regulatory Environment Scores in 57 Economies by Region

Changes in Regulations Affecting the Philanthropic Sector

- Examples of Favorable Regulatory Changes
 - Simplified the registration process
 - Repealed laws exercising control over philanthropic organizations (POs)
 - Adopted or improved tax incentives for giving




Changes in Regulations Affecting the Philanthropic Sector

Examples of Restrictive Regulatory Changes

- Tightened management over foreign donations
- Required public fundraising credentials for Pos
- Unintended restrictive impact on POs of anti-money laundering or anti-terrorism laws



Philanthropic Environment in Hungary

- Favorable Conditions and Changes:
 - Ease of operating
 - Free-of-charge registration
 - Cross-sector collaboration is encouraged
 - Various tax exemptions available for POs
 - An increasing level of public trust towards POs
 - A modest growth in digital fundraising, including crowdfunding




Philanthropic Environment in Hungary

- Restrictive Conditions and Changes
 - Increased administrative requirements for POs
 - No tax benefits for individual charitable donations
 - Additional reporting requirements on crossborder donations
 - A more hostile political environment for
 - human rights organizations, and
 - advocacy organizations



Philanthropic Environment in Nigeria





- Favorable Conditions and Changes:
 - A growth in formalized and structured philanthropy
 - No tax benefits for individual charitable donations
 - Tax-deduction for certain corporate donations
 - Recent growth and recognition of social entrepreneurship




Philanthropic Environment in Nigeria

- Restrictive Conditions and Changes:
 - Bureaucratic registration process
 - Prohibition on POs with same-sex-related mission
 - Increased reporting requirements on cross-border donations
 - Possible restrictions on foreign-funded POs if the NGO Regulatory Bill was enacted

Philanthropic Environment in Venezuela



- Favorable Conditions and Changes:
 - Deductible charitable donations
 - A cultural and religious tradition of philanthropy
 - High trust in POs by society
 - Growing diaspora with philanthropic potential

Philanthropic Environment in Venezuela



- Restrictive Conditions and Changes:
 - Increasingly restrictive political and economic freedoms
 - Limitations in the ability to form organizations
 - Heavy government investigations of certain types of POs
 - Severely restricted cross-border donations
