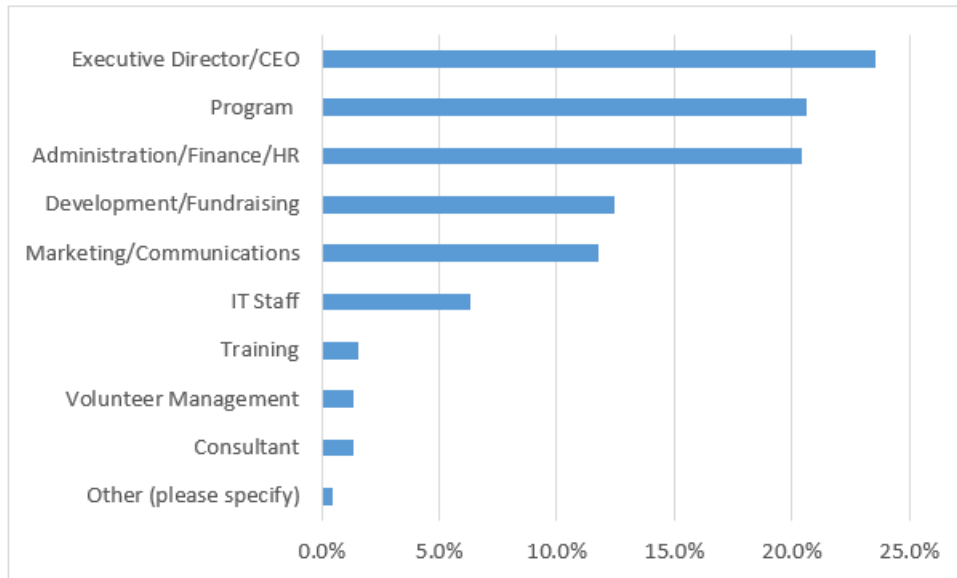

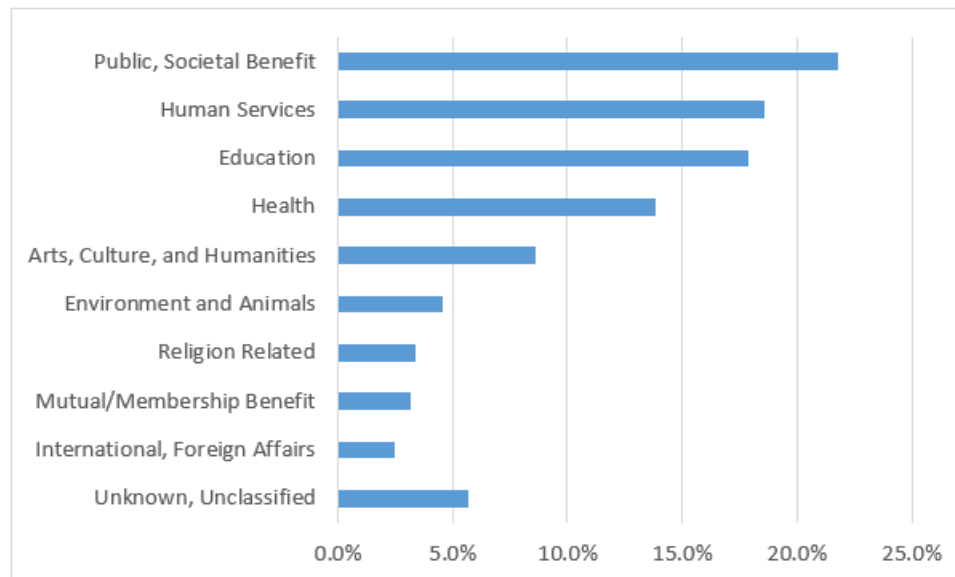

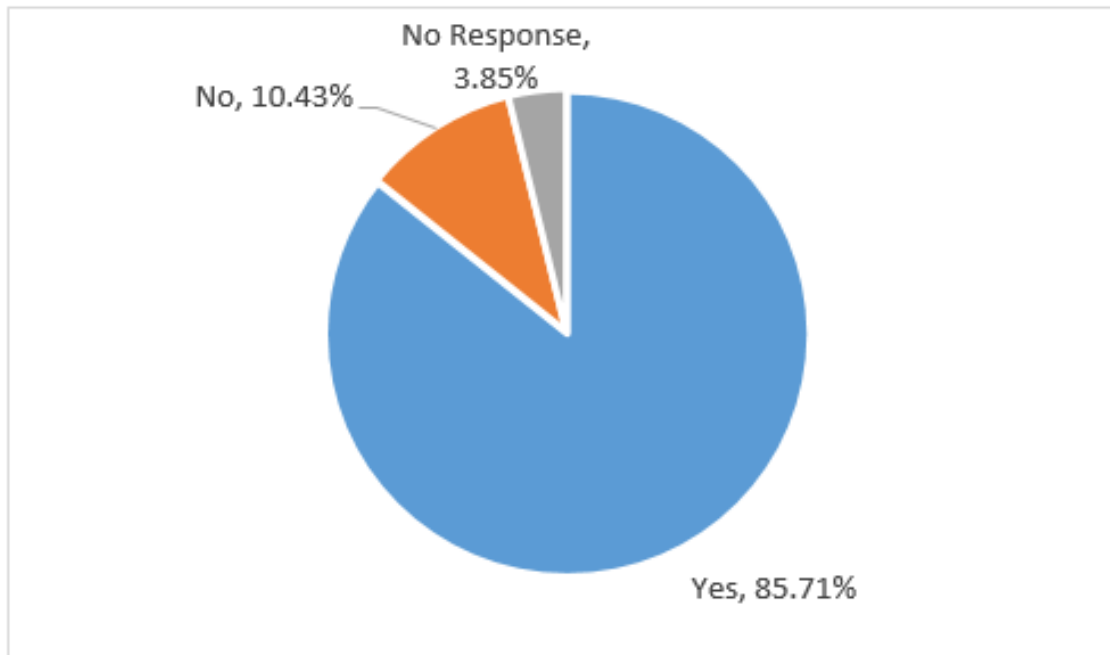
Which best represents your role or department at your organization?



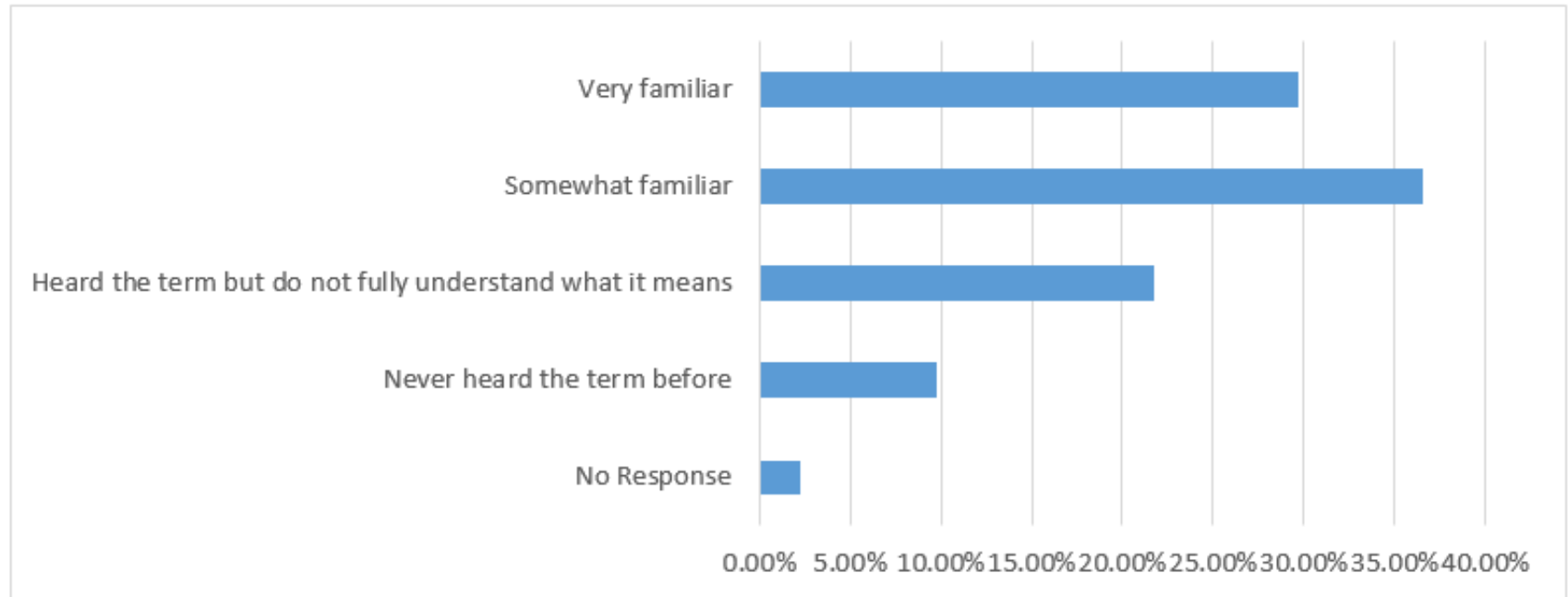
What best describes your organization's primary issue area?



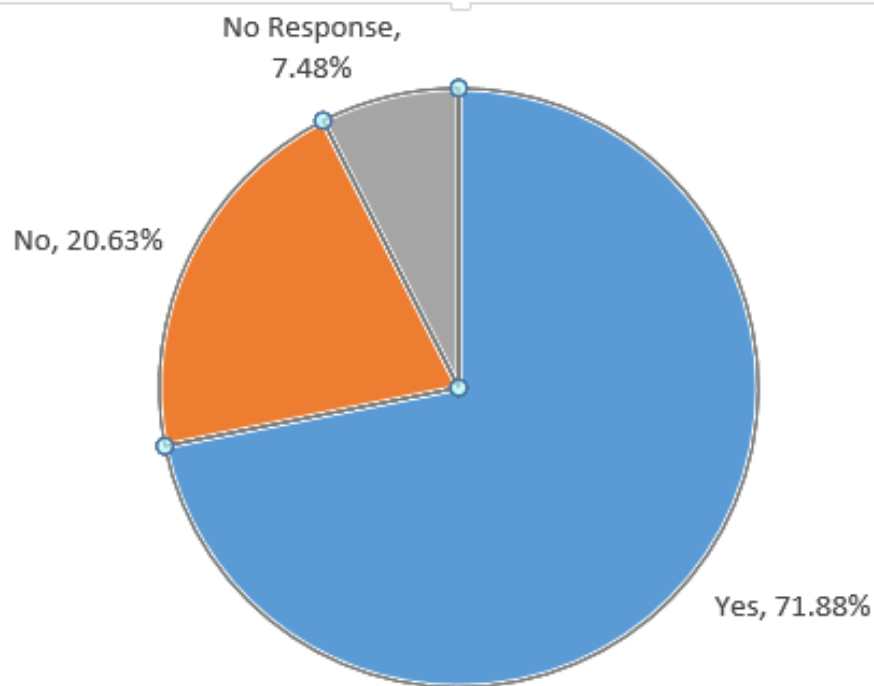
In the past 12 months, has your organization offered some form of in-person learning at least once to anyone associated with your organization?

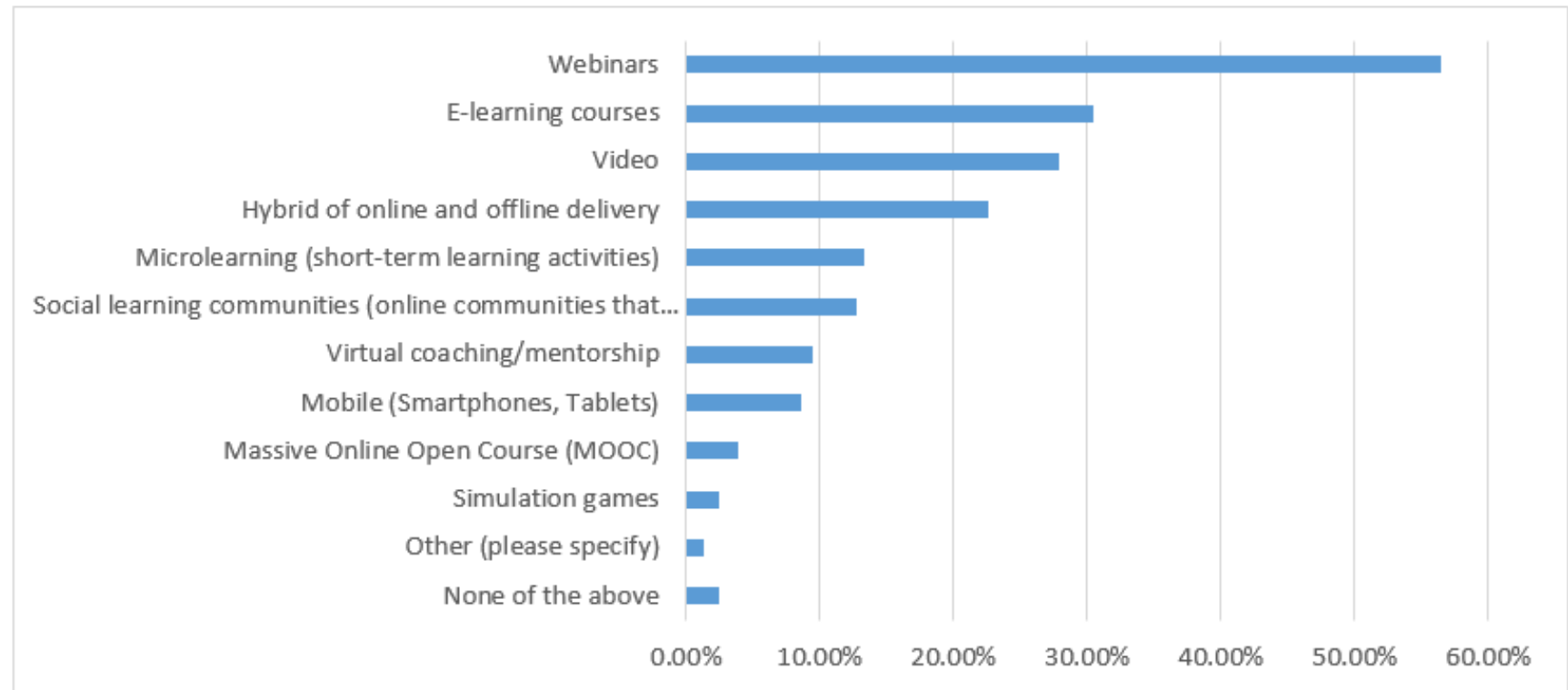

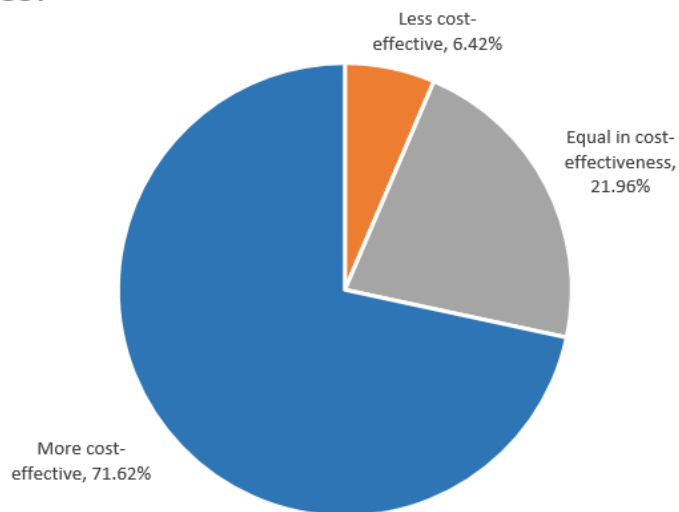

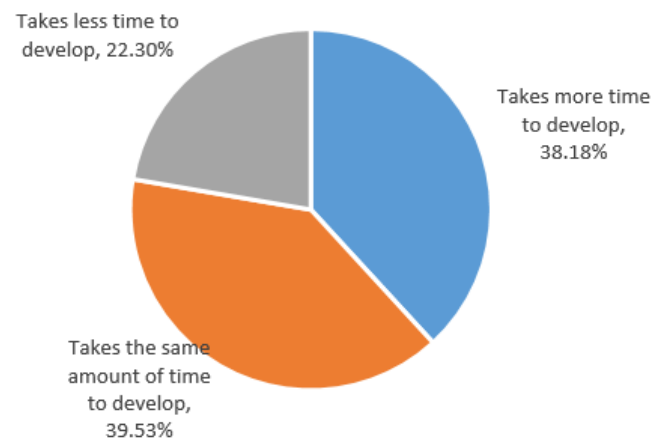


Respondents were asked to rate Technology-Based Learning on four criteria.

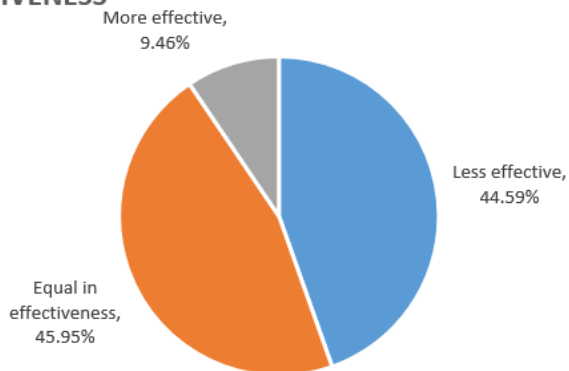

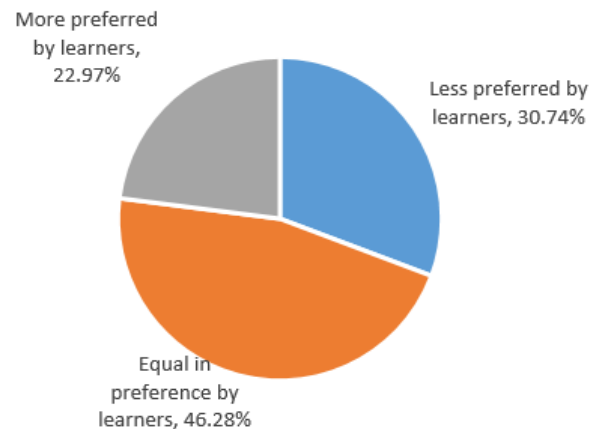

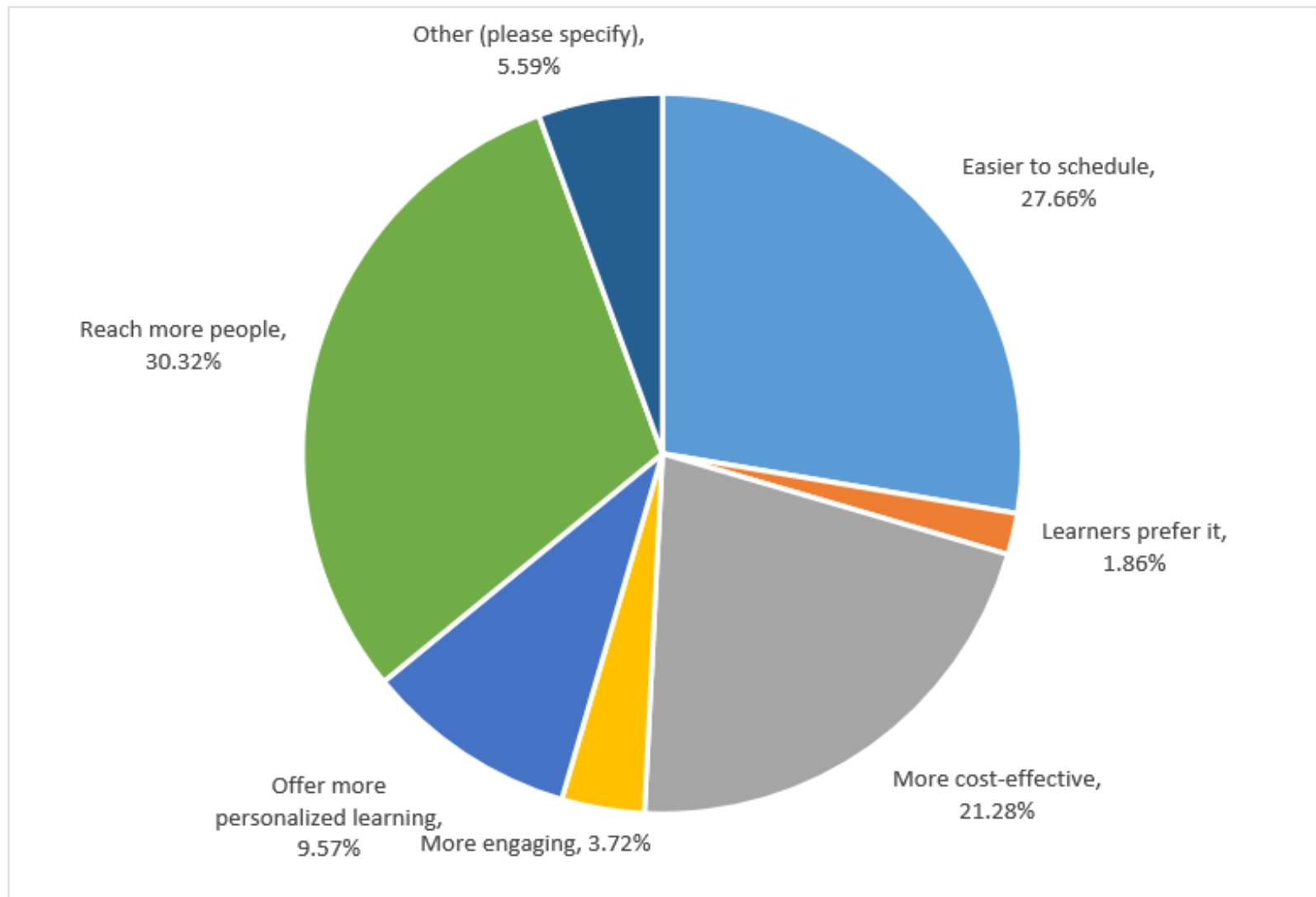

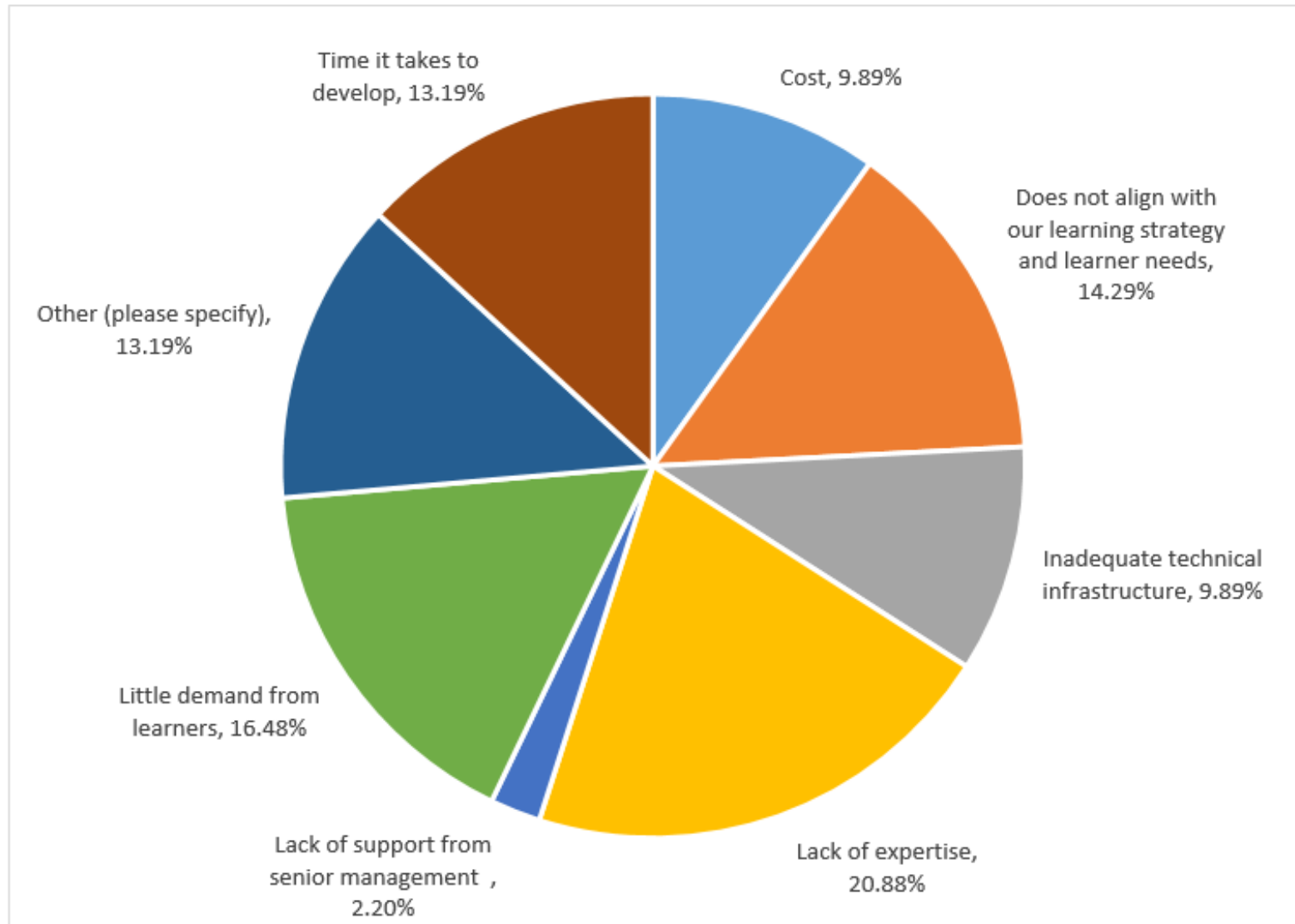
What is or could be the greatest benefit of technology based learning for your organization?

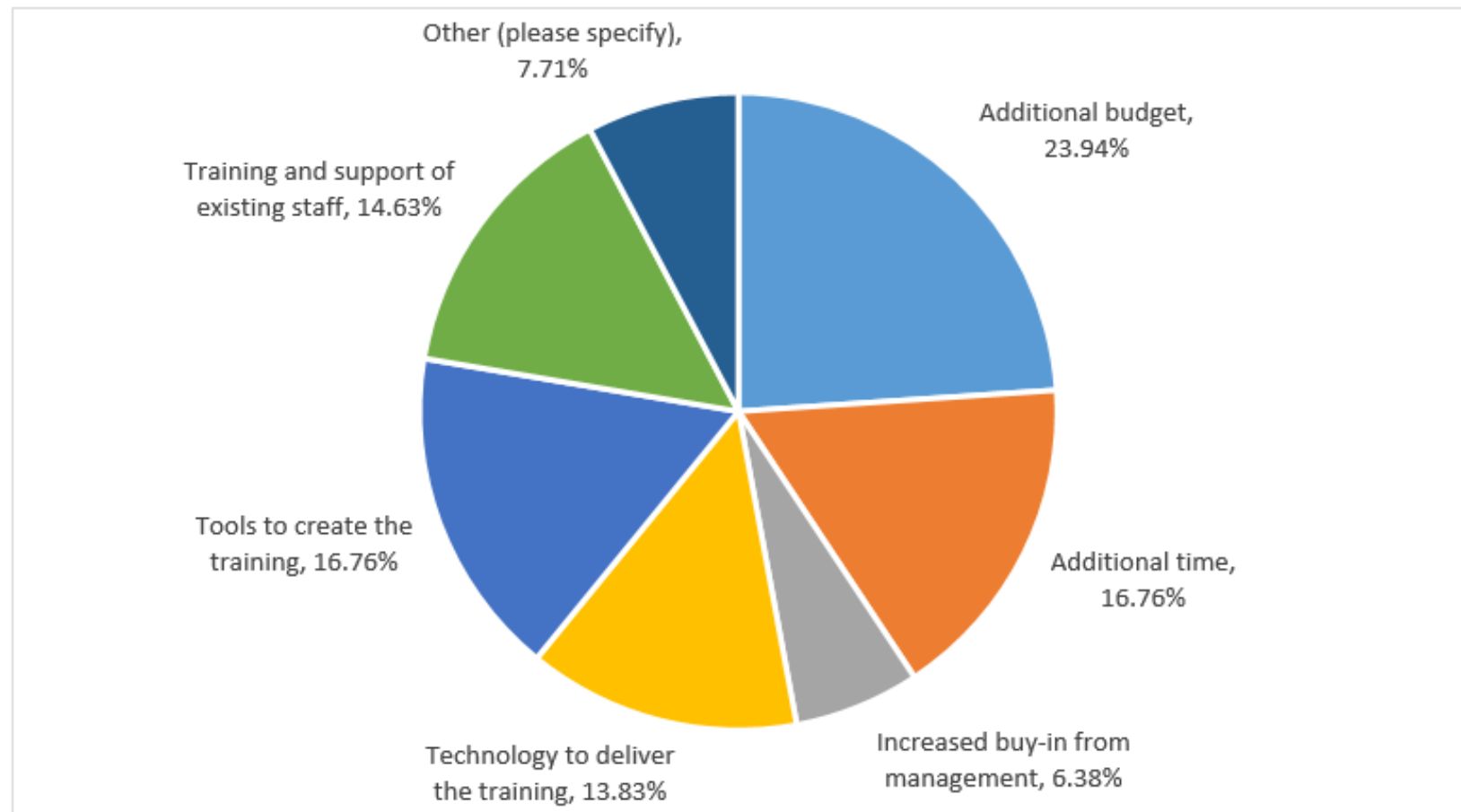
What is or could be the greatest benefit of technology-based learning for your nonprofit?

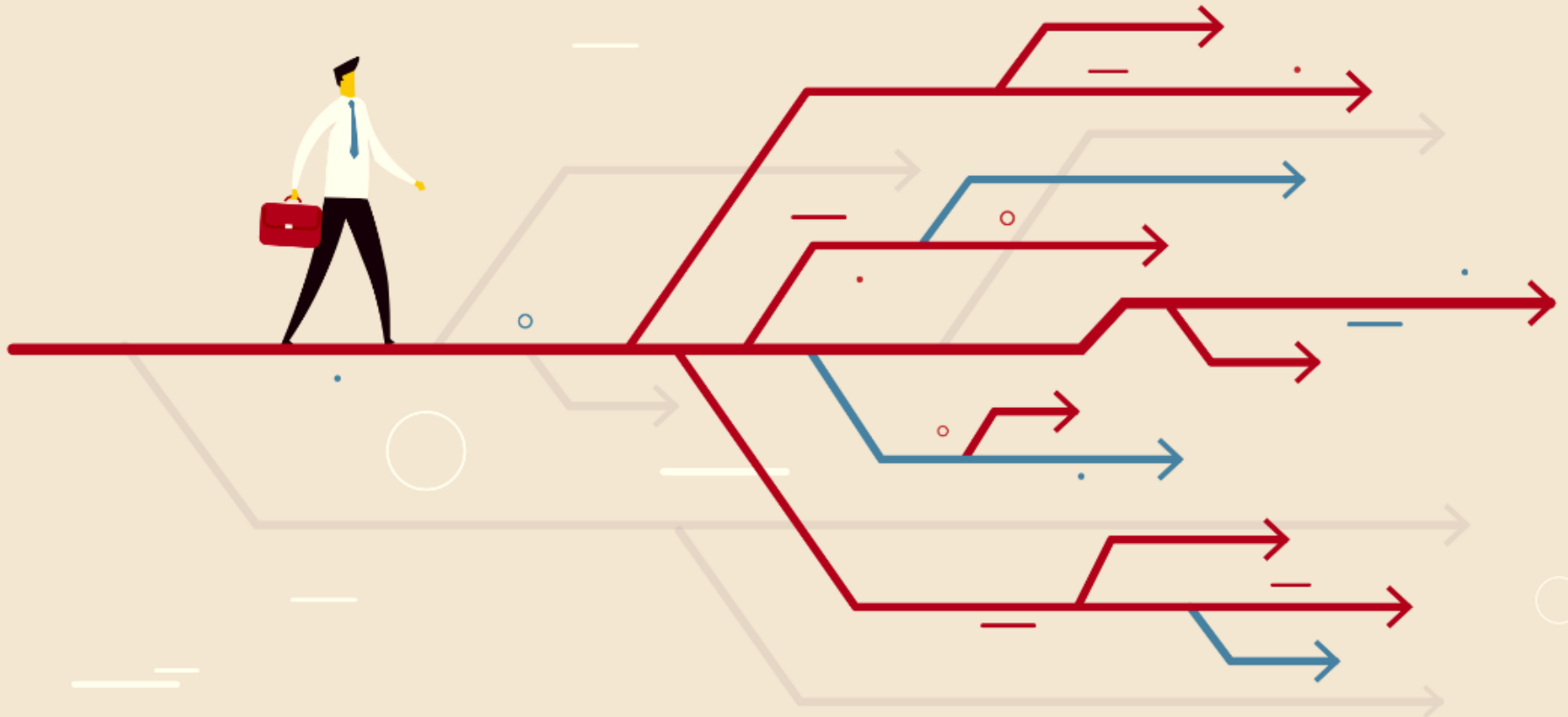

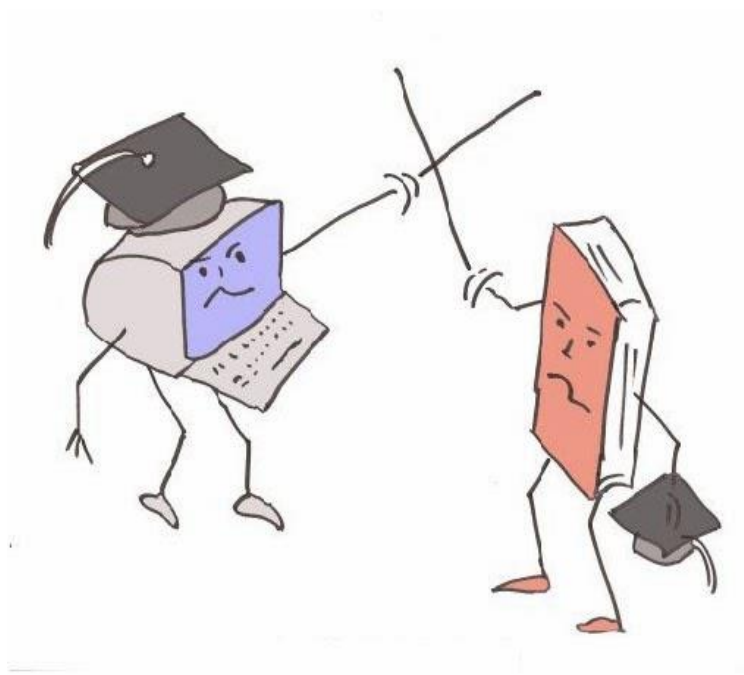

- Impacts both the Council and the organizations it serves



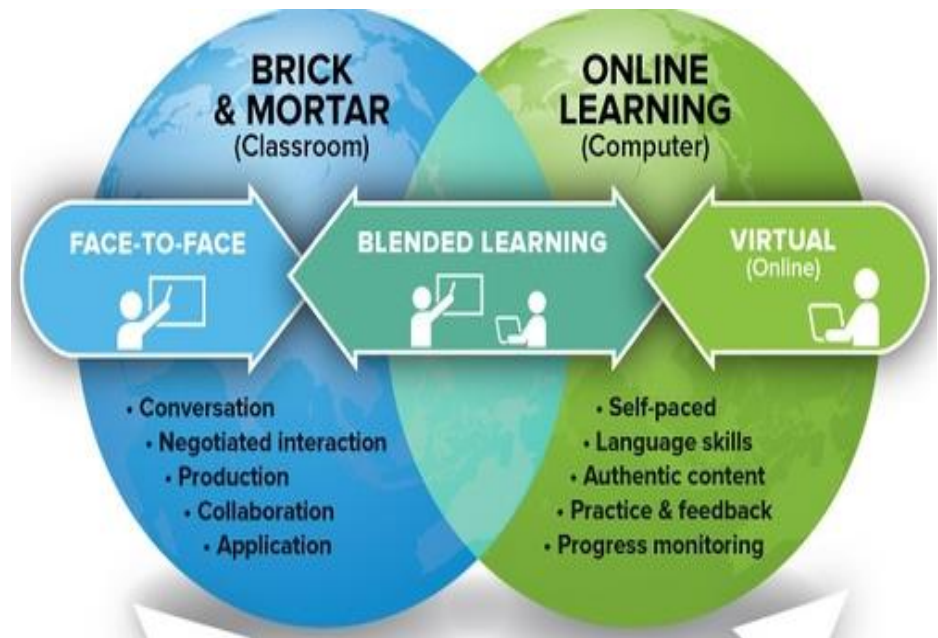
What changes were required to adapt?

- Critical component was the LMS

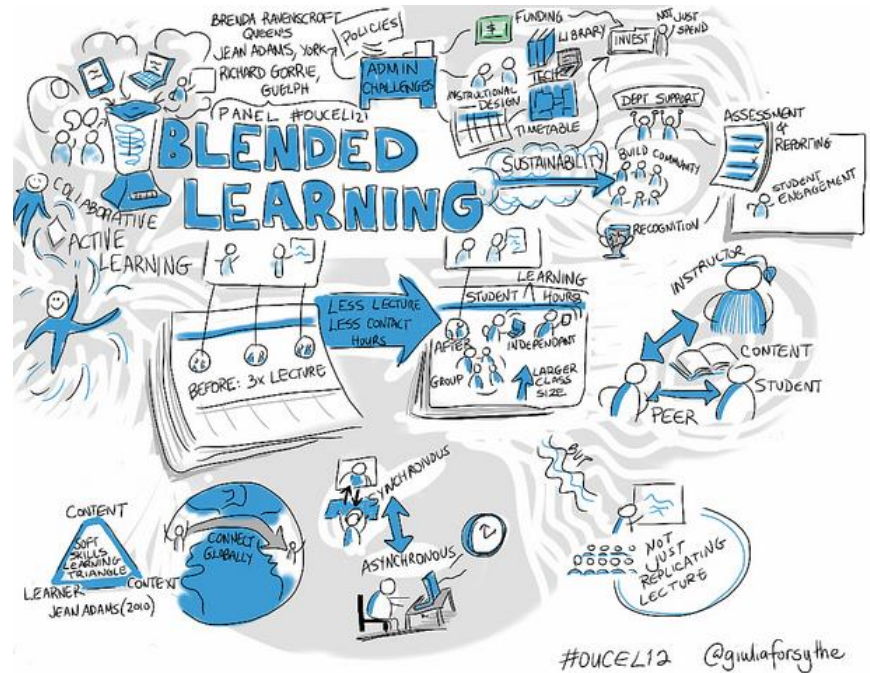
Why an LMS?

- Why is the LMS important to COF members?



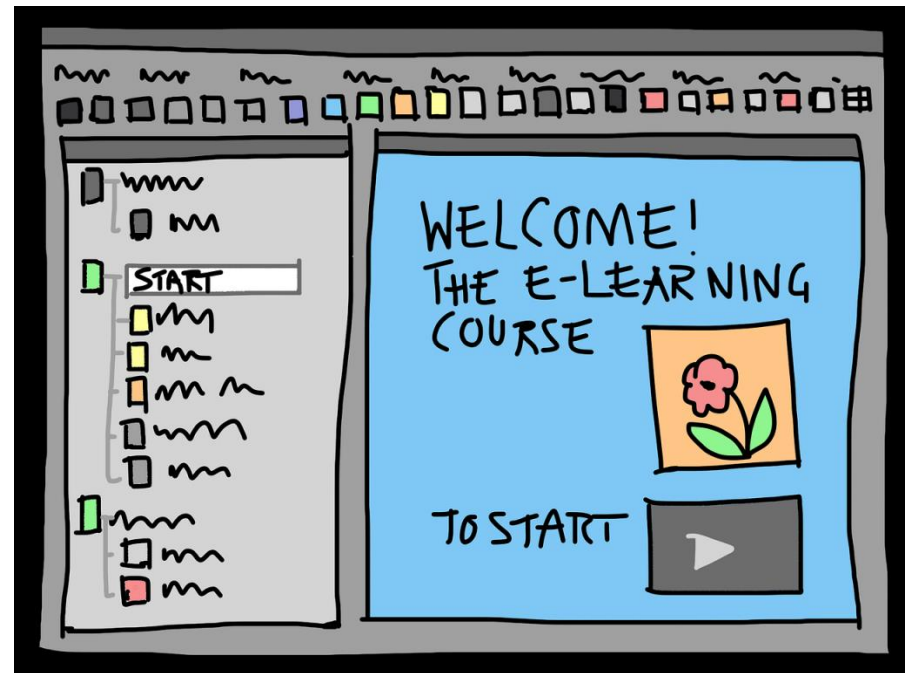
How do we plan to use the LMS?

- Converting existing professional development offerings (CCFE Affiliates, CareerPathways, etc.)
- Developing new online courses around foundation management and leadership
- Internal staff and volunteer training and development

 - Broader Reach!
- Standards and policies
- Furthering the mission of the organization
