










#### Which best represents your role or department at your organization?



#### What best describes your organization's primary issue area?




#### In the past 12 months, has your organization offered some form of in-person learning at least once to anyone associated with your organization?












Based on the definition provided, in the past 12 months has your organization offered some form of TBL at least once to anyone associated with your organization?




#### In the past 12 months, what types of technology-based learning has your organization provided? Please check all that apply.





Respondents were asked to rate Technology-Based Learning on four criteria.






What is or could be the greatest benefit of technology based learning for your organization?




#### What is or could be the greatest benefit of technology-based learning for your nonprofit?


#### Which of the following would best enable you to use (or more effectively use) technology-based learning?



- Effectiveness




# Learning is evolving

# What changes were required to adapt?




- Moving from traditional warm bodies in seats to hybrid/blended learning

#### Why an LMS?


- How will the LMS support the work of COF and its members?

## How do we plan to use the LMS?

- Converting existing professional development offerings (CCFE Affilitates, CareerPathways, etc.)
- Developing new online courses around foundation management and leadership
- Internal staff and volunteer training and development

  - Broader Reach!
